Standing with Ukraine

On 24 February the independence of Ukraine, a free democratic sovereign nation who had already given up nuclear weapons, was violated by the illegal invasion ordered by Russian dictator Vladimir Putin. This mass-murdering gangster appears to be routinely committing war crimes and represents the biggest threat to peace and freedom in Europe and beyond in 70 years. This is an important moment in history in the struggle between freedom, the rule of law and the enemies of both.

Hull has a long association with the cause of liberty and our city made huge sacrifices in standing up to and beating the Nazis in the Second World War. Hull's MPs now stand in solidarity with the people of Ukraine. It has been inspiring to see, for example at the recent vigil at Hull Minster, Hull people coming together to do what we can to support Ukrainians and their resistance.
